COOKIE POLICY

1. INTRODUCTION

We use strictly necessary, session, persistent and third-party cookies:

Strictly necessary cookies:

These cookies let you move around the Website and use essential features like secure areas. Without these cookies, we cannot provide the requested services.

We use these Strictly Necessary cookies to:

- (a) Identify you as being logged in to the website and to authenticate you;
- (b) Make sure you connect to the right service on the website when we make any changes to the way it works; and
- (c) For security purposes.

If you prevent these cookies, we can't guarantee how the Website or the security on the Website will perform during your visit.

These cookies are necessary for the Website to function and cannot be switched off in our systems. They are usually only set in response to actions made by you which amount to a request for services, such as setting your privacy preferences, logging in or filling in forms. You can set your browser to block or alert you about these cookies, but some parts of the Website will not then work. These cookies do not store any personally identifiable information.

Session cookies:

These cookies are temporary and only exist while you browse our Website. They expire at the end of a browser session when you close your browser and when you leave the Website.

Persistent cookies:
